The Roos are the junior section of Cambridge Cangaroos Trampoline Club. Formed in 2007, the Roos are specifically for children under 7 years old. We are the ONLY trampoline club in the area offering specific training opportunities for pre-school and Key Stage 1 children. Due to insurance restrictions, most recreational trampolining is only available to over 6's. As part of British Gymnastics we are able to offer training to children as young as 4.

The Roos have their own dedicated coaches, Sarah Allen, Francoise Kelly and Michael Keelin, who work under the auspices of head coach Tony Fagelman.

The Roos train on Saturday mornings 9.00-10.00am at Sawston Sports centre. The Roo's are open to children who are interested in competing in our sport.

We have had great success in the club over the last year, with all of our Roos competing in the various Open competitions in our region and we are hoping to continue that success.
